Objectives and investment policy

Objectives

The objective of this fund is to achieve a performance that is at least equal to that of medium-term Danish bonds. The share class is accumulating.

Investment policy

The fund invests mainly in highly rated investment grade Danish bonds. The fund is categorised as article 8 under SFDR and promotes environmental and/or social characteristics, as well as good governance practices, through screening, exclusions, investment analysis and decision-making as well as active ownership. The fund follows Danske Invest's responsible investment policy. The fund usually invests in securities that are rated AAA (or similar) at the time of purchase. However, it may hold securities with a lower credit rating. In actively managing the fund's portfolio, the management team selects securities


that appear to offer superior investment characteristics.

The fund may use derivatives for hedging and efficient portfolio management, as well as for investment purposes.

The total modified duration, including cash and the adjustment for estimated premature redemption risk, ranges from 2 to 5 years.




